L	Plant Mix Bituminous Concrete 301, 302, 806, or Penetration Macadam
N	Plain Concrete
P	Reinforced Concrete
R	Brick - Flexible
T	Brick - Rigid
D	Reinforced Concrete (3)
E	Plain Concrete (3)

- (2) Classified as wearing surface only on stabilized or traffic bound.
